Dear Patients:

It is with mixed emotions that I announce that I will be joining my wife in retirement in my 71st year after 43 years in family practice. **My last day in office will be May 12, 2023.** It has been my distinct privilege and an honour to have been your family doctor and been part of your lives, but I can no longer keep up with the pace of family practice.

Finding a New Doctor

Unfortunately, I have been unsuccessful in recruiting a suitable physician to take over my practice. Options for continuing care include virtual care and walk-in clinics. I recognize that changing physicians may be stressful, but I encourage you to seek continuity of care with the following suggestions to find a new doctor for yourself:

1. Ask members of your family or friends to ask their doctors if they would take you in.

3. Contact RSRS (see below). They often are aware of physicians accepting new patients.

If you have an urgent medical matter in the absence of a doctor, please proceed to the nearest emergency room.

Your Medical Record

The College of Physicians & Surgeons requires me to store all original patient record(s) for a period before they can be destroyed. I have selected **RSRS**, a physician-managed company, to safely and securely store all patient records from my practice. RSRS will also assist you in **obtaining a certified copy of your medical file for yourself and/or your new physician**. Requests for your records by a new physician's office can be faxed in to RSRS at 1-877-398-5932 or emailed to info@rsrs.com

As a last piece of medical advice, **I encourage each of you to arrange for the transfer of your record as it is a very important file for your continued care and should be accessible at all times**, even (and especially) in the absence of a new doctor. (I have included an infographic illustrating 10 reasons why). While there is a fee for the copy/transfer of medical records, it is not prohibitive.
