Notice of Practice Closure

Dear Patients,

I am writing to let you know that I will be closing my Family Practice, effective **June 28th, 2024**. I have been looking very hard for a replacement for the last two and a half years with no success. Although I am sad to leave family practice it is time for me to do so. I am looking forward to continuing to do MAID work and I will be involved in a project providing care to the Homeless population in Peterborough.

I recognize that this may be upsetting news for you. I am truly sorry that I have not been able to find a replacement, but sadly I am not surprised. The province of Ontario currently has 2.3 million people who do not have access to primary care, and less and less new graduates are choosing Family Practice. None of us, as patients or health care providers, think this is acceptable, and I urge you to lobby your MPP on this issue.

Between now and when the practice closes I am able to do phone or in person appointments, please specify at the time of booking which you prefer. If you only need medication renewals you may have your pharmacy fax us this request. There will be no charge for this service and I will put as many repeats on your prescriptions as is medically safe for me to do so.

Your Medical Record

I am required by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario to store all original patient records for a period before they can be destroyed. *Your medical record does not automatically follow you when you leave a medical practice, unless you arrange for it.* I have selected RSRS, a physician-managed company, to safely and securely store all patient records from my practice. RSRS will also assist you in obtaining a searchable copy of your medical file for yourself and/or your new healthcare provider.

I encourage you to obtain a copy of your personal medical history. It is a very important file for your continued care and should be accessible at all times, *especially in the absence of a new doctor*. I have included an infographic illustrating 10 reasons why the record is so important. While there is a fee for the copy/transfer of medical records, it is not prohibitive.
