Finding a New Doctor

1. Ask family and friends to ask their doctors if they would take you in.
2. Contact "Nova Scotia Health Authority" at 8-1-1.

In the event of a medical emergency, patients are instructed to go to the Yarmouth Regional Hospital Emergency department.

Your Medical Record

I am required to store all patient records for a period of time before they can be destroyed. I've selected RSRS to safely and securely store all patient records from my practice. They will also assist you in obtaining a *certified copy* for yourself and/or a new doctor.

I urge you to arrange for the transfer of your record as it is very important for your continued care, even in the absence of a new doctor. Please do not delay in making arrangements.
