Update to Practice Closure Notice

Dear Patients:

I hope this letter finds you well. As you are likely already aware, I closed my family practice on February 9, 2022 and I'm writing you to update you with information that will assist in your continuity of care.

Finding a New Doctor

Unfortunately, there is no further news with respect to any other physician available to take over all of my patients' care. I offer you the following suggestions to source a new doctor, which you should pursue immediately, if you haven't yet.

1. Ask family and friends to ask their doctors if they can take you in.
2. Call the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario at 416-967-2603.
3. Call "Health care Connect" at 1-800-445-1822 or register online at <https://www.ontario.ca/page/find-family-doctor-or-nurse-practitioner>
4. Contact RSRS (see below). They are often aware of physicians accepting new patients.

If you have an urgent medical matter in the absence of a family doctor, please proceed to the nearest emergency room.

Your Medical Records

The College of Physicians & Surgeons requires me to store all original patient records for a period before they can be destroyed. I've selected **RSRS**, a physician-managed company to safely and securely store all patient records from my practice. RSRS will also assist you in **obtaining a certified copy of your medical file for yourself or your new physician.**

I encourage each of you to arrange for the transfer of your record as it is a very important file for your continued care and should be accessible at all times, especially if you don't yet have a new doctor. I am including an infographic below which illustrates the top 10 reasons for obtaining your record. While there is a fee for the copy/transfer of medical records, it is not prohibitive.
