To join either of these or any other doctor's practice, I recommend that you obtain a copy of your medical records from RSRS in advance of your first appointment to bring with you. (See "Your Medical Record" section below)

Alternatively, you can use the following options to locate a new physician:

1. Ask family and friends if they can try and get you in with their doctor.
2. Speak to your local pharmacist who may be aware of new physicians in your area.

4. Contact **RSRS** (see below). They have various resources that can assist you while you are searching for a new doctor.

If you have an urgent medical matter in the absence of a doctor, please proceed to the nearest emergency room.

Your Medical Record

I am required by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario to store all original patient records for a period before they can be destroyed. *Your medical record does not automatically follow you when you leave a medical practice, unless you arrange for it.* I have selected RSRS, a physician-managed company, to safely and securely store all patient records from my practice, and to assist you in obtaining a certified and searchable copy for yourself and/or your new physician.

I encourage you to obtain a certified copy of your personal medical history. It is a very important file for your continued care and should be accessible at all times, *especially in the absence of a new doctor.* I have included an infographic illustrating 10 reasons why getting your record is so valuable

Please contact RSRS at your first opportunity for help with next steps in your care following my closure, and with respect to your medical record copy. It's possible that they may contact you as well, to ensure that all of my active patients have been properly notified.

Please be advised that there may be a 2-4 month wait time for the initial meet and greet appointment

A separate form needs to be completed for anyone in your household who is 16 years old or older (i.e. you cannot add a child 16 years old or older as a dependent on a parent's form).

Clinic Policies:

1. Our physicians work together with nurse practitioners (NPs) to deliver comprehensive care. All medical concerns are reviewed by our physicians, however, you may often be able to secure an appointment with one of our nurse practitioners earlier than with your physician.
2. Our administrative team works hard to meet our patients' needs in a timely manner. To optimize this, email is our primary means of communication between patients and our clinic staff. Emails and voicemails will be responded to on the same day during office hours (Monday to Friday, 9:00am to 5:00pm), or the next business day at the latest.
3. We acknowledge that the North York community is diverse and our clinic has staff that can communicate in some languages other than English. However, English is our clinic's primary language of operation and communication. We cannot always guarantee that a physician or NP who speaks a language other than English will be available, and in these cases it is the patient's responsibility to bring an interpreter to their appointment.
