Finding a New Doctor

As you may know, there exists a shortage of family doctors in Ontario, and I have had no success in finding a replacement. Here are a few options to find a new health care provider:

1. You can ask friends and family for referrals to their family doctors.
2. Contact the Essex County Medical Society at 519-256-4611.
3. Register with Health care Connect" at 1-800-445-1822 – this is a Ministry of Health Initiative which helps Ontarians find a new health care provider.
4. Use the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario's FIND A DOCTOR search
(<https://doctors.cpso.on.ca/?search=general>).
5. Contact **RSRS, Inc.** (see below). They often know physicians accepting new patients in your community.

Your Medical Record

I am required by the College of Physicians & Surgeons to store all original patient records for a period before they can be destroyed. I have selected **RSRS**, a physician-managed company to safely and securely store all patient records from my practice and to assist you in **obtaining a certified copy for yourself.**

As a last piece of medical advice, I encourage that you obtain a copy of your personal medical history from RSRS. This information is important for your continued care and may not be available to you or your next healthcare provider otherwise. Please inform any specialist you may be attending of your new family doctor's name and location. (I have included an infographic illustrating 10 reasons why). While there is a fee for the copy/transfer of medical records, it is not prohibitive. Please do not delay in making arrangements by contacting RSRS today. Please proceed on the web to:
