Leaving my practice after this lengthy period of time is not easy and is very bittersweet. However, I believe it is time to begin a new phase of my life while I am still healthy and energetic, and I look forward to it but will miss you all.

It has been a privilege and an honour to have helped you with your medical needs over the years.

Your Ongoing Medical Care

Finding a new physician is challenging at this time. That is why I am happy to inform you that I have made arrangements with Dr. Amir Zohrab Beik to take on the care of my patients. Dr. Beik is located across the hall from my office in the same medical building, 4949 Bathurst St., Suite 212. I highly recommend Dr. Beik. He is an excellent physician and wonderful person. You will continue to be under my care until November 30, 2024, but I will stop seeing patients November 15, 2024.

As an introduction to meeting Dr. Beik, Dr. Beik's office will be calling all of my patients over a period of a few months, beginning September 15, 2024, for a short meet and greet session.

His office will call you in order of your age, with the oldest being called first. Please be patient as everyone will eventually be called, but you must wait your turn.

His office will not be able to handle a sudden surge of calls. He will be seeing my patients in an organized manner over a period of a few months. If you are not feeling well and need immediate care before you are called or need to arrange an urgent test or x-ray follow up, you may call Dr. Beik's office and the secretary will attempt to accommodate you.

Of course, you are free to go to any family physician that you wish, if you prefer not to see Dr. Beik and prefer to see a different family physician.

Your Medical Record

I am required by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario to store all original patient records for a period of 10 years from the last visit before they can be destroyed. Your medical records do not automatically follow you to Dr. Beik's practice or anywhere else. You must make these arrangements yourself by calling RSRS in advance.

I have selected RSRS, a physician-managed company, to safely and securely store all patient records from my practice and to assist you in obtaining a certified and searchable copy of your medical file for yourself and/or new physician.

I encourage you to obtain a certified copy of your personal medical history. They will be available starting December 1, 2024. It is a very important file for your continued care and should be accessible at all times, especially in the absence of a new doctor.
