Notice of Practice Closure

Dear Patients:

After careful consideration, it is with profound sadness that I must inform you that I have closed my general practice as of **May 1st, 2025**. It has been a privilege and an honour to have helped you with your medical needs over the years.

Finding a New Doctor

Unfortunately, I have not found a physician to take over the practice. I recognize that finding a new physician is challenging. I encourage you to be proactive in your healthcare management during this time. Your medical record is an important piece of this (see below). Here are some suggestions to assist you for ongoing care:

1. Ask family and friends if their doctor may be accepting new patients.
2. Speak to your local pharmacist who may be aware of new physicians in your area.
3. Please call or visit community clinic websites to stay up to date with possible doctors who may be accepting new patients. Contact **RSRS** (see below). They often are aware of physicians accepting new patients.

If you have an urgent medical matter in the absence of a doctor, please proceed to the nearest emergency room.

Your Medical Record

I am required by the College of Physicians and Surgeons to store all original patient records for a period before they can be destroyed. I have selected **RSRS**, a physician-managed company, to safely and securely store all patient records from my practice, and to assist you in obtaining a certified and searchable copy for yourself *and* for your new physician (who will not receive it otherwise). While there is a provincial system that carries some of your information, it is not complete, nor is it the same as the record I've accumulated about you

I encourage you to obtain a certified copy of your personal medical history without delay. It is a very important file for your continued care and should be accessible at all times, *especially in the absence of a new doctor*. I have included an infographic illustrating 10 reasons why getting your record is so valuable.

Please contact RSRS at your first opportunity for help with next steps in your care and your medical record following my closure. It's possible that they may contact you as well, to ensure that you have been properly notified.
