Dr. Loiskandl has arranged for your medical records to be stored electronically by a company called RSRS. If you elect to proceed with this service, they will send me an electronic copy of your file as well that we can then upload into our electronic medical record. Although patients are responsible for the cost associated with this service, I encourage all, especially those with chronic medical conditions, to do so in order to transfer care as seamlessly as possible. I will not have access to your previous records otherwise.

I completed my undergraduate and medical degrees at the University of British Columbia before attending the University of Toronto for my family medicine residency. I then completed a Fellowship in Primary Care Sports Medicine through Western University at the Fowler Kennedy Sport Medicine Clinic and received my Diploma in Sport and Exercise Medicine from the Canadian Academy of Sport and Exercise Medicine in 2013. I currently have a primary care sports medicine practice in Collingwood at Peak to Shore Physiotherapy and Sports Medicine and, until opening my new practice, continue to see family practice patients at the Moran Medical Centre in Collingwood and at Canadian Forces Base Borden in Angus. In addition to continuing my work at Peak to Shore after March 1st, I also plan on continuing as an orthopedic surgical assistant at the Collingwood General and Marine Hospital.

I have worked as team physician for numerous sports organizations, including Canada Basketball, and am actively involved in teaching medical students and residents. I currently hold the appointment of Assistant Clinical Professor (Adjunct) in the Department of Family Medicine at McMaster University.

Prior to moving to Collingwood in 2016, I spent years travelling and working with my wife in Toronto, Christchurch, New Zealand and Kelowna, British Columbia. My wife, Krissy is a Registered Nurse in the Emergency Department at Collingwood General and Marine Hospital and we love exploring South Georgian Bay with our daughter, Ellison and dog, Bondi.

My office partner, Dr Randall Mintz, will also be taking over another physician's practice in February.
