It is with mixed emotions that I am writing to inform you that after 32 years, I will be retiring from family practice. My last day seeing patients will be January 12, 2018. I will, of course, be available until that date to see you for medical problems and for renewal of prescriptions.

Finding a New Doctor

Unfortunately, I have not been able to find anyone to take over my practice, therefore, I would urge you to begin seeking another health professional to take over your care. You can also call them at 604-733-7758. Also, consider using your personal network to find a physician. A family member or friend may be able to ask if his/her doctor is taking new patients. Your Medical Record

Your original medical record must be safely stored for a period of time before it can be shredded. I have arranged with RSRS, a physician-managed facility to safely store all records from my practice and assist you in obtaining a certified copy. Your medical record is very important for the future of your healthcare. I strongly urge you to obtain a copy as soon as possible, regardless of whether or not you find a doctor immediately, and whether you or your new doctor takes a copy. It is important that you can access this information whenever it's needed.
